RESOLUTION 90-116

DELETING THE POSITION OF SPECIAL ASSISTANT TO THE MAYOR - OIL SPILL LIAISON AND ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF SENIOR CLERK TYPIST - EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

WHEREAS, activities related to the Exxon Valdez oil spill and future oil spill planning are entering a new phase and the mayor's special assistant position is no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the state's Department of Environmental Conservation has approved a grant funding a clerical position through June 30, 1991 to assist the borough's Office of Emergency Management in administering and coordinating related oil spill activities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the position of Special Assistant to the Mayor - Oil Spill Liaison is deleted.

Section 2. That the position of Senior Clerk Typist - Emergency Management, Range I, is established at 32 hours per week through February 28, 1991 and 40 hours a week thereafter until June 30, 1991.

Section 3. That the attached job description for Senior Clerk - Typist (10/30/90) is approved and incorporated by reference.


Section 4. That the Senior Clerk Typist - Emergency Management position will be automatically deleted upon exhaustion of state funding or when the position is no longer needed, whichever comes first.

Section 5. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
