KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 90-119

REQUESTING ALASKA LEGAL SERVICES CORPORATION TO ESTABLISH AN OFFICE IN KENAI, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, Alaska Legal Services does not have an office located in any community on the Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, there are a number of people residing on the Kenai Peninsula who require legal services and cannot afford to retain counsel; and

WHEREAS, the need to provide legal services to these people exceeds the ability of local attorneys to provide those services on a pro bono basis; and

WHEREAS, the people who reside on the Peninsula and use Alaska Legal Services Corporation must make arrangements to deal with an office in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the difficulties in using Alaska Legal Services renders it impossible for many persons to obtain legal assistance; and

WHEREAS, an office located in Kenai could make delivery of legal services more effective for an area that includes nearly 10% of the population of the State;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Assembly request that Alaska Legal Services Corporation undertake the steps necessary to establish an office in Kenai, Alaska to serve the Alaska residents living in that area.

Section 2. That copies of this resolution shall be sent to the Executive Director of Alaska Legal Services Corporation.
