RESOLUTION 90-125

ALLOWING MARATHON OIL COMPANY AND THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE TO USE THE PHEROMONE, MCH FOR A BARK BEETLE REMEDIATION PLAN ALONG A PIPELINE RIGHT-OF-WAY OVER BOROUGH LANDS NEAR BELUGA

WHEREAS, Marathon Oil Company has requested and received authorization by Resolution 90-51 to enter on Borough lands and construct an underground pipeline; and

WHEREAS, Marathon Oil Company has requested permission to apply and study an anti-aggregating pheromone, MCH to portions of the cleared right-of-way to aid in the prevention and suppression of spruce bark beetle infestations; and

WHEREAS, the application and administration of this project will be undertaken by the U.S. Forest Service; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way permit issued to Marathon Oil Company requires Borough consent before any chemicals or sprays are used for bark beetle control; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission reviewed this request at its meeting of November 19, 1990, and recommended approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That permission is granted to Marathon Oil Company and the U.S. Forest Service for a two-year bark beetle remediation plan and project on that portion of Borough lands located within the cleared pipeline right-of-way within Sections 4, 7, 8, 18, 19, and 30, Township 12 North, Range 10 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, containing approximately four (4) acres.


Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate this permission.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
