RESOLUTION 90-14

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SITE SELECTION FOR THE FIRE TRAINING FACILITY

WHEREAS, the University of Alaska is planning the development of a fire training facility within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough is the local planning authority and has expertise that may be available to the site selection process; and

WHEREAS, the location of the fire school may affect industrial and residential planning in the area of the Kenai Peninsula Borough outside of the cities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough hereby requests the University of Alaska to include the municipality in the committee charged with site selection authority for the location of the new fire school for those areas under consideration which are located outside of cities.


Section 2. That a copy of this resolution shall be directed to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation, Department of Natural Resources, University of Alaska and Senators Binkley, Fischer, Kerttula, and Szymanski; Representatives Kubina, Navarre, Swackhammer, Wallis and Zawacki.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its enactment.
