RESOLUTION 90-20

DIRECTING THE BOROUGH CLERK TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR FURNISHING LEGAL SERVICES TO THE ASSEMBLY

WHEREAS, the borough attorney furnishes legal advice to the borough mayor, school board, school administration and assembly; and

WHEREAS, conflicts may arise; and

WHEREAS, a new budget period is approaching;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the borough clerk is hereby directed to solicit proposals for furnishing legal services to the assembly for the fiscal year 1990-91 by publishing in the major newspapers in the state and mailing inquiries to members of the Alaska Bar Association. The proposals should include various alternatives such as:

1. Availability on call of the assembly president to provide legal advice as requested;
2. Reviewing assembly packets and attending assembly meetings to advise the assembly as necessary;
3. Assist assembly committees in drafting legislation;
4. Assist assembly members in reviewing legislation;
5. Represent the assembly in litigation.
