RESOLUTION 90-23

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

WHEREAS, There are at least 696 delinquent personal property tax accounts in excess of \$500 due; and

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited proposals from attorneys to collect these accounts; and


WHEREAS, after review of the proposals and interviews, the proposal of Robert J. Molloy, Attorney at law, was selected as the best proposal for providing the collection services;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Robert J. Molloy, for the collection of delinquent personal property tax accounts. The terms of the agreement shall be upon such terms and conditions as the Mayor deems in the best interest of the Borough and in accord with the proposal submitted.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
