KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 90-26 (SUBSTITUTE)

PLACING A PROPOSITION BEFORE THE VOTERS WHICH WOULD AUTHORIZE THE ASSEMBLY TO REMOVE RESTRICTIONS ON HIRING AND EXPENDITURES FROM THE NON-AREAWIDE PORT AND HARBOR POWERS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

WHEREAS, the ordinances and voter approval governing non-areawide port and harbor powers impose limitations on expenditures and hiring or use of employees beyond those normally imposed on carrying out Borough functions; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of removing those limitations would be to allow the Borough to reasonably administer those powers; and

WHEREAS, voter authorization from the area outside cities should be obtained for removal of those limitations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition be placed before the voters in areas outside of cities at the October 2, 1990, municipal election:

PROPOSITION: Authorizing removal of limitations on the exercise of non-areawide port and harbor powers of the Borough. Do you authorize the Assembly to remove restrictions originally imposed by the Assembly and voters on the exercise of the power that prevents the Borough use of employees or Borough funds to implement the non-areawide port and harbor powers?


