RESOLUTION 90-31

SUPPORTING CHANGES IN TITLE 17 OF THE ALASKA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE DEALING WITH THE OPERATIONS OF TRACTOR TRAILER TRUCKS PULLING A COMBINATION OF TRAILERS ON KENAI PENINSULA ROADS

WHEREAS, under current regulations truck tractors with combinations of two trailer units up to 90 feet in length, also known as long doubles, may operate on the Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS, due to the types of roads and their conditions and weather encountered during winter months, October through April, the safety of motorist traffic on Kenai Peninsula roads is jeopardized by the use of double tractor trailers during these conditions; and

WHEREAS, with the amount of traffic found on Kenai Peninsula roads during the period of April 16th to October 15th, double tractor trailer units should be limited to those traffic periods to ensure motorist safety;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. The Kenai Peninsula Borough supports regulation changes to Title 17 of the Alaska Administrative Code limiting the use of double tractor trailers to the period of April 16th to October 15th of each year on Kenai Peninsula roads.

Section 2. The Kenai Peninsula Borough further supports limiting the use of double tractor trailers to low traffic periods certain days of the week through the period of April 16th to October 15th of each year.

Section 3. The Clerk shall send copies of this resolution to Bruce R. Freitag, DOT Maintenance Engineer; Senator Lloyd Jones, Chair Senate Transportation Committee, Rep. Richard Foster, Chair House Transportation Committee; Senators Binkley, Fischer, Kerttula and Szymanski; Representatives Kubina, Navarre, Swackhammer, Wallis and Zawacki.
