RESOLUTION 90-34

DECLARING A SIEMENS MAMMOMAT (MAMMOGRAM MACHINE) SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE BY SEALED BID

WHEREAS, the Central Kenai Peninsula Hospital has a Siemens Mammomat, model #7208804X1047, serial number 01049507, surplus to its needs; and

WHEREAS, this machine was purchased in 1983 for \$69,270; and

WHEREAS, a machine of this type and value would have no use to the general public and, therefore, should not be sold at public auction;

WHEREAS, Borough Code requires that all agencies of the Borough shall be notified that surplus property is available for agency use; and

WHEREAS, South Peninsula Hospital has been notified of the surplus machine and has declined, and they are the only suitable agency in the Borough that could have used this machine;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Siemens Mammomat, model 7208804X1047, serial number 01049507, is declared surplus to the needs of the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

Section 2. That the Siemens Mammomat will be sold by sealed bid according to Chapter 5.28.500 of the Borough Code.

Section 3. That subsection 5.28.500 D of the Borough Code, which requires notice to all agencies of the Borough 30 days prior to sale, is waived.

Section 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
