KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 90-42

APPROVING AWARD OF CONTRACT TO THE SELDOVIA OIL SPILL TEAM FOR THE SPRING BEACH CLEAN UP AND SPILL RESPONSE ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) and the Kenai Peninsula Borough entered into a memorandum of agreement executed January 25, 1990, by which ADEC agrees to reimburse KPB for actual expenses incurred in performing oil spill response activities; and

WHEREAS, because of the many and varied coastal areas affected by the oil spill from the T/V Exxon Valdez, is necessary for the Borough to provide for response activities of different types and by different groups to meet the specific needs of each affected area; and

WHEREAS, it is of benefit to the Borough to utilize local resources for equipment and personnel utilized in response efforts in order that these funds may be distributed throughout the areas affected by the oil spill; and

WHEREAS, residents of the Seldovia area have formed a nonprofit corporation entitled the "Seldovia Oil Spill Team" for the purpose of setting up and administering an oil spill response organization in compliance with the requirements of the ADEC/KPB Memorandum of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this nonprofit corporation whose membership includes more than 40 residents of the Seldovia area, has provided a proposed work plan which has been accepted by the Kenai Regional MAC Group for response activities in the Seldovia area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to execute a contract in accordance with the terms and conditions as approved by the Kenai Regional MAC Group with the Seldovia Oil Spill Team for oil spill response activities.


Section 2. That all activities provided for under the contract shall be within the scope of work provided by the

Memorandum of Agreement between ADEC and the Kenai Peninsula Borough as reimbursable oil spill response activities.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
