RESOLUTION 90-46

PROVIDING FOR BALLOT PROPOSITIONS TO APPROVE THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE PURPOSES BY THE CENTRAL KENAI PENINSULA ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICE AREA, EAST KENAI PENINSULA ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICE AREA, NORTH KENAI PENINSULA ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICE AREA, AND SOUTH KENAI PENINSULA ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough, through its four road maintenance service areas, provides for limited road maintenance paid for strictly through State of Alaska grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the funding level for the State grant programs for road maintenance has been reduced significantly in recent years; and

WHEREAS, the road maintenance service areas have necessarily been spending from their fund balances in order to continue providing equal road maintenance services with the reduced State funding; and

WHEREAS, those road maintenance service area fund balances have now been reduced to the point where the service areas must either reduce the level of service or seek additional funding through a tax on service area residents; and

WHEREAS, each of the four road maintenance service area boards has requested that a proposition be placed before their voters residing within their service area boundaries at the next regular Borough election on October 2, 1990, which would provide for the levy of a tax for road maintenance purposes not to exceed 0.5 mills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following proposition shall be placed on the ballot to be voted upon by voters within each of the four Borough road maintenance service areas at the next regular election on October 2, 1990:
