RESOLUTION 90-81

CHANGING ONE PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHER TO LEAD PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHER IN THE 911 COMMUNICATIONS CENTER

WHEREAS, the 911 Communications Center operates three shifts on a 24-hour basis; and

WHEREAS, there is only one state supervisor for all dispatchers; and

WHEREAS, the State Troopers wish to establish two lead positions to oversee their respective shifts; and

WHEREAS, they have requested that one of lead positions be from the five dispatchers the borough currently provides; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the recently approved budget to cover the cost of an upgrade; and


WHEREAS, the 911 Communications Board of Directors has agreed to the above;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That one public safety dispatcher position is changed to lead public safety dispatcher and the attached job description is approved and incorporated by reference.

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
