RESOLUTION 90-99

TRANSFERRING A TOTAL OF \$20,330 FROM THE ASSEMBLY CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT TO THE ASSEMBLY OFFICE MACHINES ACCOUNT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ASSEMBLY VOTING EQUIPMENT AND TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE MACHINES ACCOUNT FOR A PRINTER.

WHEREAS, the voting system in the Assembly Room experiences numerous breakdowns with limited availability of servicing and should be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the International Association of Municipal Clerks reported that only two companies, Daktronic and Datavote, provide voting equipment and, upon contact, only Daktronic responded with a quote; and

WHEREAS, the information received from Daktronic was reviewed by the Maintenance and Data Processing personnel for configuration and compatibility and there appear to be no problems; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk's Office is in need of a new printer to replace the one currently being borrowed from the Legal Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That \$18,585.00 is transferred from Account 100-111010-49999, Assembly Contingency to Account 100-111010-48120, Assembly Office Machines, to provide funds for Assembly room voting equipment.


Section 2: That a contract be let to Daktronic, Inc. to provide the hardware, software, and installation supervision of their voting system as per their proposal.

Section 3: That \$1,745.00 is transferred from Account 100-111010-49999, Assembly Contingency, to Account 100-111020-48120, Assembly Clerk Office Machines, for the purchase of a printer.


Section 4: That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
