RESOLUTION 91-4

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE USED OIL COLLECTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the borough has solicited proposals for this project; and

WHEREAS, the highest rated proposal was submitted by Alaska Pollution Control. The proposal is fair and reasonable, and the proposer is qualified for this project according to the terms and conditions of the contract documents; and

WHEREAS, the lowest priced proposal did not contain information regarding disposal of the oil, and thus was the lowest rated proposal; and

WHEREAS, funds are available for completion of this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to proceed with award of contract to Alaska Pollution Control, in the amount of Seventeen Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$17,600) for the used oil collection program at four Borough solid waste facilities.

Section 2. That all expenditures for this project will be charged to Account Number 100.320010.43011.


Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.
