GRANTING AN EASEMENT TO HOMER ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION, INC. ON AND ACROSS BOROUGH OWNED LANDS BEING SOLDOTNA HIGH SCHOOL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the borough has received patent number 4412 from the State of Alaska for Soldotna High School known as the  $NW_4^1$  SE $_4^1$  Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 10 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has requested a public utility easement for an underground electrical service line to be located on said borough owned lands; and

WHEREAS, Homer Electric Association has provided information concerning the location and width of the easement needed; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District reviewed this request and has no reason to object to the easement being granted; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission reviewed this request at its January 28, 1991 meeting and recommended the easement be granted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the mayor is authorized to execute such documents, upon such conditions deemed to be in the best interest of the borough as necessary to grant an easement for public utilities across that portion of Soldotna High School property within the  $NW_4^1$  SE $_4^1$  Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 10 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, running  $\pm$  695 feet in length and containing 0.12 acres, more or less, and shall extend a width of 10 feet.

<u>Section 2</u>. A sketch map revealing the location of the easement granted shall be attached and made a part of the executed document.

Section 3. That this resolution takes effect upon its adoption.
