RESOLUTION 91-31 (SUBSTITUTE)

RECOGNIZING THE NIKISKI SENIOR CITIZENS, INC., FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE BOROUGH'S SENIOR CITIZENS GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., is a nonprofit corporation in the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, KPB 5.22 provides funding for senior citizens organizations meeting the conditions of the ordinance; and

WHEREAS, there are 148 senior citizens in the Nikiski 1 and Nikiski 2 precincts based on the 1984 census; and

WHEREAS, many senior citizens do not utilize the Kenai Senior Center because of the distance involved, and would use services closer to home, if available; and

WHEREAS, the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., seeks recognition of the Assembly to be eligible to receive senior citizens program funding from the Borough;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recognizes the Nikiski Senior Citizens, Inc., as a senior citizens organization eligible to participate in senior citizens funding by the Kenai Peninsula Borough under Chapter 5.22 of the Borough Code.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
