RESOLUTION 91-38

ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR APPOINTMENTS TO COOK INLET REGIONAL CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL, COOK INLET SPILL PREVENTION AND RESPONSE, INC. AND TO THE PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND REGIONAL CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, federal laws require development of spill prevention and response plans; and

WHEREAS, those same laws provide for citizen participation in reviewing spill prevention and response plans; and

WHEREAS, the Cook Inlet Regional Citizens Advisory Council, and the Prince William Sound Regional Citizens Advisory Council were formed to fulfil the review plans developed for Cook Inlet and Prince William Sound; and

WHEREAS, Cook Inlet Spill Prevention and Response, Inc., was formed jointly by those involved in the petroleum industry in Cook Inlet to provide an organization capable of developing spill prevention and response plans and providing response as needed; and

WHEREAS, the borough has representation in each of these organizations; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public to provide for appointments to these various organizations in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity of the review of any plans;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly shall make appointments of Kenai Peninsula Borough representatives to the Cook Inlet Regional Citizens Advisory Council and the Prince William Sound Regional Citizens Advisory Council. The Assembly shall provide for nomination by assembly members for consideration for appointment for vacancies in borough-appointed seats in these organizations and the assembly shall select the appointee from those nominees. The nomination process shall conform to any requirements of the particular organization for selection of the Kenai Peninsula Borough representatives.


Section 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough mayor, or his designee, shall serve as the Kenai Peninsula Borough representative on the Cook Inlet Spill Prevention and Response, Inc., board of directors.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
