RESOLUTION 91-41

CLASSIFYING BOROUGH OWNED LANDS IN THE KARLUK REEF SUBDIVISION AND KARLUK REEF SUBDIVISION ADDITION 1 TO CLASSIFICATION OF "PUBLIC USE-LANDS" FOR A FIRE STATION SITE FOR THE KALIFORNSKY BEACH FIRE SERVICE AREA

WHEREAS, the Kalifornsky Beach Fire Service Area has been actively seeking a location for a site on which to construct a fire station and related facilities; and

WHEREAS, the borough has title to Tract B, Karluk Reef Subdivision Addition 1; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Kalifornsky Beach Fire Service Area has identified the aforementioned parcels as a suitable location for a fire station and requested the parcels be classified for said use; and

WHEREAS, comments and recommendations for the classification were requested from the school district, service areas and departments of the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission reviewed the classification at its meeting of April 1, 1991 and recommended adoption.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following described lands located within Section 20, Township 5 North, Range 11 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, are hereby classified as "Retain for Public Use" for use by the Kalifornsky Beach Fire Service Area:

Tract B, Karluk Reef Subdivision Addition 1, containing 3.67 acres, more or less; and,

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
