KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 91-53

SETTING AN ADVISORY VOTE WITHIN THE NIKISKI FIRE SERVICE AREA, THE NORTH PENINSULA RECREATION SERVICE AREA AND THE NORTH PENINSULA ROAD SERVICE AREA REGARDING COMBINING THOSE SERVICE AREAS

WHEREAS, the fire and ambulance, road maintenance, and recreation services are provided by three separate service areas in the North Kenai and the upper west side of Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of these service areas are almost identical; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Constitution and statutes contemplate the least number of overlapping local government units; and

WHEREAS, consolidation of these service areas would provide services with fewer layers of government and provide a more cohesive structure for responding to the residents in providing those services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a question shall be placed before the voters of the Nikiski Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area, and the North Peninsula Road Service Area at the next regular municipal election regarding the advisability of consolidating these three service areas into a single service area to provide the same services.

Section 2. The ballot proposition shall read:

PROPOSITION: (Advisory only) Should the Nikiski Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area, and the North Peninsula Road Service Area be combined into a single service area to provide the same services currently provided by these three separate units of local government?
