RESOLUTION 91-57

AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF A FREE USE PERMIT TO THE CITY OF HOMER FOR A PORTION OF TRACT 3 NEW HOMER HIGH SCHOOL SUBDIVISION NO. 2 TO BE UTILIZED AS A MEMORIAL PARK BY THE BPOE HOMER EMBLEM CLUB NO. 350

WHEREAS, title to Tract 3, New Homer High School Subdivision No. 2 vests in the borough; and

WHEREAS, the BPOE Homer Emblem Club No. 350 has an existing memorial park established within a portion of said tract; and

WHEREAS, the BPOE Homer Emblem Club No. 350 contacted the Mayor of the City of Homer requesting that the permit be issued to the City of Homer for liability purposes; and

WHEREAS, requests for review and comments were sent to the City of Homer Advisory Planning Commission, Kenai Peninsula Borough School District, South Peninsula Hospital Service Area, South Peninsula Road Service Area and borough departments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer Advisory Planning Commission met April 10, 1991 and voiced no objection to the issuance of a free use permit; and


WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission met May 6, 1991 and recommended that a free use permit be issued to the City of Homer authorizing the BPOE Homer Emblem Club No. 350 to utilize a portion of Tract 3, New Homer High School Sub. No. 2 as a memorial park.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a free use permit be issued for a memorial park to the City of Homer for a portion of Tract 3, New Homer High School Subdivision No. 2 as depicted on Attachment A, an as-built survey prepared by Ability Surveys.

Section 2. That the Mayor is authorized to sign such documents deemed necessary and to be in the best interests of the borough.
