KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH

RESOLUTION 91-73

PROVIDING FOR A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF A NONAREAWIDE POWER OF THE BOROUGH TO FORM SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS TO ALLOW FOR CONSTRUCTION OF EXTENSION OF UTILITY LINES

WHEREAS, the need exists to extend utility lines in a number of areas of the Borough including but not limited to gas lines; and

WHEREAS, securing the funds for the cost of improvements makes extension of these lines difficult in the areas of low population or those areas that are more remote; and

WHEREAS, formation of special assessment districts to construct or extend utility lines with the repayment of the special assessments by the property owners benefitting from the improvement would be a mechanism to meet the needs of these residents; and

WHEREAS, the Borough currently does not have the power to construct or provide for utilities of this type; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of the necessary power requires voter authorization;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1: That a question shall be placed on the ballot at the next general election to provide for the acquisition of the power of the Borough to construct or arrange for the construction of utility lines or extensions made through the formation of special assessment districts. The proposition shall read as follows:

PROPOSITION _____. Shall the Borough be authorized to provide for utility lines or extensions in the area outside cities through the formation of special assessment districts for repayment of costs by the benefitted property owners?
