RESOLUTION 91-78

SUPPORTING THE INCORPORATION OF THE NIKISKI AREA

WHEREAS, the people of the Nikiski area have historically and consistently advocated local community control of services; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Service Areas have been providing fire (since 1968), recreation (since 1973), and road (since 1983) services; and

WHEREAS, the incorporation of Nikiski would allow for the maximum citizen input of participation into the local decision making process involved in planning, land use, and resource development; and

WHEREAS, the people have expressed a desire to ensure the continued viability of Nikiski as a residential, industrial, commercial and recreational area offering its citizens a quality life style;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the incorporation of Nikiski as a second class city within the boundaries decided by the Boundary Commission.

Section 2. That copies of this resolution be distributed to the Commissioner of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
