RESOLUTION 91-87

CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LANDS LOCATED WITHIN SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 8 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, SEWARD MERIDIAN, ALASKA AS RETAINED LANDS TO BE USED FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES AND NATURE TRAILS

WHEREAS, the borough has received state patent to certain lands located within Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M.; and,

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District has requested that certain lands within Section 36, T8N, R12W, S.M., be classified for educational purposes and nature trails; and,

WHEREAS, review and comments were requested from borough departments, school district, service areas and any other interested parties, in accordance with standard procedures;

WHEREAS, the borough Planning Commission recommended the classification be changed to include only the East one-half (E 1/2) of Government Lot 2, but otherwise approved the proposed classification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That the following described lands are classified as "Retained Lands" for educational purposes and nature trails:


E 1/2 of Government Lot 2 and the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 36, T8N, R12W, Seward Meridian, containing 68 acres, more or less.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
