RESOLUTION 91-88

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE PREPARATION OF TWO STORAGE CELLS AT THE HOMER BALING FACILITY AND THE RELOCATION OF APPROXIMATELY 460 CUBIC YARDS OF PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOIL FROM HOMER HIGH TO THE NEW CELLS

WHEREAS, the Borough Finance Director solicited and received bid proposals for the labor and equipment required to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, five (5) bid proposals were received and the low successful qualifying bidder was Paul's Services with a bid of Twenty-six Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$26,560);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to award a contract in the amount of \$26,560 to Paul's Services for preparation of two storage cells at the Homer Baling Facility and the relocation of approximately 460 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil from Homer High School to the new cells.

Section 2. That funds are available for this project in Account No. 265-325060-49999-91001.


Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.
