**A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION ON OCTOBER 1, 1991,  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING AN ASSEMBLY MEMBER,  
DISTRICT II, SEAT D, FOR A ONE-YEAR UNEXPIRED TERM**

**WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly accepted the resignation of Patrick O'Connell at its regular meeting of August 6, 1991; and

**WHEREAS,** there is now a vacancy on the Assembly for an unexpired one-year term; and

**WHEREAS,** Alaska Statutes provide for a successor to be appointed within 30 days to serve until the next regular election; and

**WHEREAS,** the next regular election is October 1, 1991, however, the filing period for that election has already been advertised and has begun;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:**


**Section 1.** That a Special Election be held on October 1, 1991, in conjunction with the Regular Election for the purpose of electing an Assembly Member, District II, Seat D, to a one-year unexpired term.

**Section 2.** That there will be a special filing period opening August 8 at 8:00 a.m. and closing August 20 at Noon for this seat. Nominations will be made in accordance with KPB 4.10.
