RESOLUTION 91-103

**PLACING THE QUESTION OF ACQUIRING NON-AREAWIDE POWER TO
MAINTAIN AND IMPROVE ROADS ON THE OCTOBER 1991 BALLOT**

WHEREAS, non-areawide power to maintain and improve roads would provide for more consistent road service throughout the borough; and

WHEREAS, deteriorating road conditions within the Kenai Peninsula Borough road maintenance system requires improvements to keep future maintenance costs to a minimum; and

WHEREAS, special assessment districts to finance local road improvements have been requested by property owners in the area outside cities; and

WHEREAS, past road service area boards have resisted the special assessment district concept as their funds are to be used for maintenance and not improvements; and

WHEREAS, acquisition of these powers on a non-areawide basis requires approval of the voters on a non-areawide basis;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA
BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:**

Section 1. That the following be placed before the voters on a non-areawide basis at the Regular Borough Election to be held October 1, 1991:

Proposition

Shall the Kenai Peninsula Borough have the powers necessary to provide for the maintenance and improvement of roads in the area of the borough outside of cities?

Section 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
