KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 91-104

AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF FOREST RESOURCES ON BOROUGH LANDS
IN COOPER LANDING

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough under the Municipal Entitlement Act has received the Final Decision on August 23, 1989 granting the borough management authority for lands in Cooper Landing; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Forest Management Plan allows for timber disposal and the State of Alaska, Division of Forestry has previously established these timber sales for future disposal; and

WHEREAS, disposal of timber infested by the spruce bark beetle would be good forest management and help with the reduction of fuel loads that pose a fire danger to the community of Cooper Landing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

Section 1. That a commercial sale of timber in Cooper Landing be allowed for timber and firewood. The Mayor is authorized to conduct personal use firewood log sales where conditions permit after conduct of the commercial sale.

Section 2. That this sale shall be in accordance with KPB Chapter 17.50.030 "Forest Management" on said sales:

Snug Harbor Salvage Unit 11 in Section 33,
T5N, R3W, S.M.

Bench Top Salvage in Section 31, T5N, R3W,
S.M.

Stringer Salvage in Section 21, 27, and 28,
T5N, R3W, S.M.


Stetson Creek Trail Salvage in Section 31,
T5N, R3W, S.M.


Section 3. That the mayor is authorized to sign such documents necessary to effectuate these sales.
