RESOLUTION 91-119

SUPPORTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES PROJECT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND UPGRADE OF THE EXIT GLACIER ROAD

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, has designed a construction project for the Exit Glacier Road which will include construction of a new road between the Seward Highway and Mile 3.9 of the existing road; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration has stated its support for the project and has suggested a submission of request for construction funding which must be submitted by September 27, 1991; and

WHEREAS, that request must include documentation of local support for the construction project; and


WHEREAS, the Assembly is aware that meetings are scheduled in Seward to review the plans for the project on September 25 and 26, 1991, and that objection to the plans might be raised as a result of this review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


Section 1. That the Assembly supports the concept of the proposed Exit Glacier Road construction and upgrade project, subject to public comment, and encourages the State of Alaska to submit a request for Federal funding.
