BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Alaska Department of Transportation is requested to undertake an immediate upgrade of the Island Lake Road and North Spur Highway intersection.
- **SECTION 2.** That DOT is requested to implement all procedures, devices and upgrades at this intersection at the <u>earliest date</u> to address the safety deficiencies inherent to this intersection.
- SECTION 3. That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Tony Knowles, DOT Commissioner Joe Perkins, John Horn, DOT Central Region, Representatives Mike Navarre, Gail Phillips, Gary Davis and Senators Judy Salo and John Torgerson.
