**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 95-068**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A POPULATION ADJUSTMENT FOR THE ENTIRE
KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND
REGIONAL AFFAIRS**

WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Regional Affairs is charged by statute with determining the July 1, 1995 population of each municipality for the FY 97 State Revenue Sharing and Municipal Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, in determining the population for State Revenue Sharing Population purposes, the total population of the borough, including cities within the borough, is used; and

WHEREAS, each municipality has an opportunity to request an adjustment by using a method of population determination approved by Department of Community and Regional Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer conducted a Housing Unit Method population estimate, and the Community and Regional Affairs has approved this figure to be 4,133 persons, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seldovia conducted a "head count" census of the municipal population, and the Community and Regional Affairs has approved the figure of 334 persons;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. The cities of Homer and Seldovia have passed resolutions adopting the results of their census.


SECTION 2. The Kenai Peninsula Borough requests a population adjustment for FY 97 for the entire Borough's population from the Department of Community and Regional Affairs to include the revised population counts as follows:

City of Homer	4,133
City of Kachemak	404
City of Kenai	7,006
City of Seldovia	334
City of Seward	3,034
City of Soldotna	3,990
Remainder of the Borough	<u>28,200</u>
Kenai Peninsula Borough	47,101

SECTION 3. A copy of this resolution will be sent to the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs.


SECTION 4. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
