A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CLASSIFICATION OF BOROUGH OWNED LANDS IN CONJUNCTION WITH COMPLETION OF COMMUNITY LAND USE PLANS

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough will receive municipal entitlement of 155,780 acres of land under AS 29.65.010; and

- WHEREAS, the borough has received approximately 80,000 acres under AS 29.65.010; and
- WHEREAS, borough lands should be classified after consideration of community land use issues; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Department has adopted a schedule for classification of borough lands; and
- **WHEREAS**, several communities have formed or are forming advisory planning commissions that can assist the borough in completing community land use plans; and
- WHEREAS, KPB 17.10.080 (F) provides for individuals to request classification or reclassification; and
- **WHEREAS,** the last three of four applications by individuals requesting classification have been postponed until a community land use plan is completed for the area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the Planning Department establish as a top priority completion of its land entitlement under AS 29.65.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Planning Department establish as a top priority for FY 96/97 the completion of community land use plans as identified in the October 16, 1995 memorandum from Roy Dudley, Land Management Officer to Lisa Parker, Planning Director.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
