**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 95-076**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE'S COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM IN COOPERATION WITH THE
ANCHOR POINT SENIOR CITIZENS, INC.**

- WHEREAS**, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs that grant funding is available for the 1995 federal fiscal year through the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"); and
- WHEREAS**, eligible applicants include any municipal government entity as defined by Title 29, except the Municipality of Anchorage; and
- WHEREAS**, an eligible applicant may submit a CDBG grant application in cooperation with a non-municipal entity such as a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20, which is in good standing with the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS**, the Anchor Point Senior Citizens, Inc., is a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20, in good standing with the State of Alaska; and
- WHEREAS**, the Anchor Point Senior Citizens, Inc., has requested the Borough to submit an application in cooperation with them for a grant in an amount up to \$200,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs under the CDBG program for the construction of a senior citizen center; and
- WHEREAS**, a project involving the construction of a senior citizen center meets the preliminary eligibility criteria as a limited clientele activity under the CDBG program's community development category;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate, execute, and submit to the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs any and all documents required for a cooperative application on behalf of the Anchor Point Senior Citizens, Inc., for a grant up to \$200,000 under the CDBG program for construction of a senior citizen center.


SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
