**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 96-001**

**A RESOLUTION RELINQUISHING MUNICIPAL ENTITLEMENT SELECTION AND  
AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO QUIT CLAIM TO THE STATE OF ALASKA  
ANY INTEREST IT MAY HAVE IN ALASKA STATE LAND SURVEY NO. 83-157  
CONTAINING FIVE ACRES LOCATED IN THE POINT POSSESSION VICINITY**

**WHEREAS,** in 1982 the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) received a final decision under Municipal Entitlement Selection ADL 39308 for certain land in the Point Possession vicinity; and

**WHEREAS,** the State of Alaska has not issued a patent for Municipal Entitlement Selection ADL 39308 due to a Native Allotment preference right; and

**WHEREAS,** the Native allotment has now been surveyed by Alaska State Land Survey (ASLS) No. 83-157 and conveyed to the Native allottee; and

**WHEREAS,** to clear title to ASLA 83-157 the KPB needs to quit claim to the State of Alaska the interest it received in the land described by ASLS 83-157 under the Final Decision for Municipal Entitlement Selection ADL 39308.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is authorized to issue the State of Alaska a quit claim deed for any interest the Kenai Peninsula Borough may have in ASLS 83-157, according to Plat No.84-214, Kenai Recording District, Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, containing 5.00 acres more or less.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
