## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 96-006

## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE DRAFT NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMIT PROPOSED BY THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

- WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is authorized to issue permits for discharges into the waters of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the EPA has proposed re-issuing a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit for Cook Inlet Oil and Gas Exploration, Development and Production facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed permit sets limitations and standards for the direct discharge of pollutants into surface waters; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission and the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recognize the importance of the oil and gas industry to the Kenai Peninsula Borough economy.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough has an interest in maintaining the environmental quality of the coastal waters and in supporting petroleum exploration, production, manufacturing, and support industries.
- SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly encourages the Environmental Protection Agency and the State of Alaska, to work in concert with industry, public groups, and resource agencies to develop a mutually acceptable discharge monitoring permit.
- **SECTION 3.** That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Environmental Protection Agency and the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation.
- **SECTION 4.** This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
