- WHEREAS, Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. has declared one coagulation unit, two blood gas analyzers, and two liquid nitrogen tanks of no further use to the hospital and as surplus equipment; and
- WHEREAS, the above medical equipment could be hazardous if handled by non qualified individuals and should not be sold at the Kenai Peninsula Borough and School District annual surplus property auction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc. is authorized to conduct a sealed bid sale of their surplus medical equipment (specifically: Coag-a-Mate XC coagulation unit SN 099XC1274RA, CPGH #1668; Ciba Corning 168 SN 1007, CPGH #01652; Ciba Corning 168 SN 0639, CPGH #0639; and two liquid nitrogen tanks with no serial numbers) only from qualified healthcare providers or equipment manufacturers.

SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
