**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A COMPENSATION STUDY
FOR MANAGERIAL EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, it is prudent from time to time to review the compensation given managerial employees of the borough; and

WHEREAS, many positions have changed in duties and responsibilities since the last review which took place in 1989; and

WHEREAS, the administration recommends that a study be performed; and

WHEREAS, no additional allocations are required to fund the study;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the assembly supports a study of compensation for the borough's managerial employees.


SECTION 2. That the areas addressed by the study should include the salary system, actual compensation levels, internal/external comparability, and recommendations for changes and implementation.


SECTION 3. That changes to the current compensation for managerial positions be put on hold until completion of the study.
