**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 96-062**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR COLLECTION OF
DELINQUENT PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES AND DELINQUENT SALES TAXES**

WHEREAS, there are approximately 350 delinquent personal property tax accounts in excess of \$500 due and also delinquent sales tax accounts needing collection attention; and

WHEREAS, the Borough solicited proposals from attorneys to collect these accounts; and

WHEREAS, after review of the proposals, the proposal of Molloy and Landry, Attorneys at Law, was selected as the best proposal for providing the collection services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Molloy and Landry for the collection of delinquent personal property tax accounts and delinquent sales tax accounts. The terms of the agreement shall be upon such terms and conditions as the Mayor deems in the best interest of the Borough and in accord with the proposal submitted. The agreement may be extended or renewed in accordance with the proposal and Borough Code for a period not to exceed two years.


SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
