- SECTION 2. That there will be a special filing period opening August 8 at 8:00 a.m. and closing August 15 at 4:30 p.m. for this seat. Nominations will be made in accordance with KPB 4.30.020.
- SECTION 3. That this resolution will take effect immediately upon adoption.
