KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 96-102

A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LAND LOCATED IN THE KASILOF AREA AT APPROXIMATELY MILE POST 112.5, ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STERLING HIGHWAY, SOUTH OF RED RIBBON ROAD AS RURAL

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has received State of Alaska Patent No. 7220 for the land to be classified; and
- WHEREAS, the remainder of the parcel, 238.8 acres, was proposed to be classified Rural for eventual sale; and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 17.10.080 public notice was published and notification sent to land owners and/or leaseholders of record within a one-half mile radius of the land to be classified, applicable agencies, and interested parties; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed classification September 23, 1996 during which a petition signed by more than 100 people opposing the proposed waste handling classification was submitted and hearing public comment from nine residents all opposed to the waste handling classification, the Planning Commission recommended the entire parcel be classified as rural;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That Borough land described as S½N½, N½SW¼, Section 11, T2N, R12W, Seward Meridian, Alaska, lying west of the Sterling Highway Right-of-Way, containing 238.35 acres more or less be classified as Rural.
- **SECTION 2.** That this classification shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
