**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SCHOOL BOARD'S
SELECTION OF AN ARCHITECT TO DESIGN CONSTRUCTION
OF THE NINILCHIK ELEMENTARY/HIGH SCHOOL
FOLLOWING THE NOVEMBER 8, 1996 FIRE**

WHEREAS, the Ninilchik Elementary/High School was severely damaged by fire on November 8, 1996; and

WHEREAS, at a special meeting held December 9, 1996 the Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board selected Bill Kluge to provide architectural services for the replacement of the elementary wing at Ninilchik Elementary/High School and to prepare schematic design and differential cost estimates for addition of a second floor; and

WHEREAS, AS 14.14.060(e) provides that the school board selection of professional personnel to design school buildings is subject to borough assembly approval;

WHEREAS, the assembly concurs with the school board's selection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. The Kenai Peninsula Borough School Board's selection of Bill Kluge to provide architectural services for replacement of the elementary wing at Ninilchik Elementary/High School, as well as schematic design and differential cost estimates for addition of a second floor, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
