KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 97-013

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF STATE LEGISLATION, RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETINGS HELD OUTSIDE OF JUNEAU

- WHEREAS, legislation has been introduced to the state legislature which would amend the Uniform Rules of the Alaska State legislature relating to certain committee meetings held outside of the state capital; and
- WHEREAS, Uniform Rule 23A is proposed to be amended by adding a new language which states that "each standing committee shall hold at least one meeting at a location outside of the state capital during the period beginning with the 61st day of each regular session and ending on and including the 7th day"; and
- WHEREAS, having State committee meetings held outside the capital would provide greater direct access by local citizens to their legislators and allow for greater participation in the legislative process; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly encourages its citizens to participate in all state and local government processes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the passage of legislation requiring standing committees of the State Legislature to hold meetings outside of the state capital.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
- **SECTION 3.** That copies of this resolution shall be provided to Senator Jim Duncan, Representatives Kim Elton and Bill Hudson, and to all Kenai Peninsula Borough legislators.
