- WHEREAS, in 1996 Central Peninsula General Hospital, Inc., decided to stop operating the Family Recovery Center, a drug and alcohol abuse treatment center, at Central Peninsula General Hospital; and
- WHEREAS, through adoption of KPB Resolution 96-065 the Assembly authorized the expenditure of \$100,000 to Cook Inlet Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (CICADA) to provide outpatient services to chemically dependent people, thereby partially filling the gap created by the closure of the Family Recovery Center; and
- WHEREAS, CICADA has provided a great benefit to the Kenai Peninsula Borough by assisting in meeting the needs of community through its efforts to aid persons requiring drug and alcohol abuse treatment ; and
- **WHEREAS,** it would be in the best interest of the Borough to continue a relationship/partnership with CICADA to provide their much-needed services; and
- WHEREAS, the necessity for an alcohol and drug abuse program will continue to exist in the future;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That CICADA is commended for their assistance to the Kenai Peninsula Borough in meeting the needs for an alcohol and drug abuse program within the Central Peninsula General Hospital Service Area.
- **SECTION 2.** That CICADA may be considered during the budget process as an agency to receive continued funding from the Borough for a drug and alcohol abuse treatment program for fiscal year 1997/1998.
