A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING A PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOTS 3 AND 4, SECTION 10, T5N, R9W, S.M. ALASKA, AS WASTE HANDLING

- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Solid Waste Department has identified a site to be classified Waste Handling for a potential waste handling transfer facility; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has received State of Alaska Patent No. 6923 for Government Lots 3 and 4, Section 10, T5N, R9W, S.M. Alaska, lying north of the Sterling Highway; and
- WHEREAS, in accordance with Chapter 17.10.080 public notice was published and notification sent to land owners and/or leaseholders of record within a one-half mile radius of the land to be classified, applicable agencies, and interested parties; and
- WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed classification March 10, 1997 and recommended approval of the classification by unanimous consent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** The Borough land described as Government Lots 3 and 4, Section 10, T5N, R9W, Seward Meridian, Alaska, lying north of the Sterling Highway except Quit Claim Deed recorded in Book 380, Page 957, Kenai Recording District, containing 23.35 acres more or less be classified as Waste Handling.
- **SECTION 2.** That this classification shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
