**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACTS FOR CARPET
REPLACEMENT AT MOUNTAIN VIEW ELEMENTARY, SEARS ELEMENTARY,
NORTH STAR ELEMENTARY, SOLDOTNA HIGH, STERLING ELEMENTARY
AND MCNEIL CANYON ELEMENTARY**

WHEREAS, the Maintenance Director has formally solicited and received bids for these projects;
and

WHEREAS, the low bids submitted for each project are fair and reasonable, and the bidders are
qualified to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, funds are available from the capital improvement budget for these projects;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to award a contract to Steve Rutherford Floor Covering
for carpet replacement at the following schools:

Mountain View Elementary	\$22,048.00
Sears Elementary	\$18,347.00
North Star Elementary	\$18,327.00
Sterling Elementary	\$11,890.00

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is authorized to award a contract to Commercial Contractors Inc. &
Stretch-Rite Carpet, a Joint Venture in the amount of \$19,240.00 for the carpet
replacement project at Soldotna High.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is authorized to award a contract to Rainbow Builders, Inc. in the
amount of \$6,872.00 at McNeil Canyon Elementary.


SECTION 4. That expenditures for carpet replacement will be charged to the following account numbers:

SECTION 5. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with this Resolution and contract documents.


SECTION 6. That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
