- WHEREAS, after the closure of the Central Peninsula Hospital Family Recovery Center, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly appropriated and reserved \$400,000 in the Central Peninsula General Hospital budget; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough, through resolution 96-065, authorized the expenditure of \$100,000 to the Cook Inlet Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse, \$10,000 to provide support for developing a long term plan for an alcohol and drug treatment program and \$20,000 to provide space at the hospital for detoxification treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly must approve all additional expenditures of the reserved funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That \$50,000 is authorized to be transferred from account #600-811010-49999 and granted to the Cook Inlet Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse (CICADA) for the purpose of providing out patient services.
- **SECTION 2.** That \$220,000 is authorized to be transferred from account #600-811010-49999 to the Central Peninsula General Hospital capital account for the purpose of constructing a new loading dock and improved hospital entrance.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
