**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH  
RESOLUTION 97-050**

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 97-043 AND  
SETTING FOR PUBLIC HEARING A NEW RESOLUTION  
OF NECESSITY ESTABLISHING THE ROBINSON LOOP  
SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR CONSTRUCTION  
OF A NATURAL GAS MAIN LINE**

**WHEREAS,** on June 3, 1997, the Assembly adopted *Resolution 97-043, A Resolution of Necessity Establishing the Robinson Loop Utility Special Assessment District for Construction of a Natural Gas Main Line*; and

**WHEREAS,** following adoption of the resolution it was discovered that owners of 11 of the 77 parcels affected by the proposed improvements did not receive notice of the hearing on the resolution of necessity as required by the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances; and


**WHEREAS,** as a result of this procedural error, it is necessary to rescind *Resolution 97-043*, schedule a second public hearing and consider a new resolution of necessity for the establishment of this utility special assessment district; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That *Resolution 97-043* is hereby rescinded.

**SECTION 2.** That the Borough Clerk is instructed to set for public hearing on July 15, 1997 a resolution of necessity for the establishment of the Robinson Loop Utility Special Assessment District for Construction of a Natural Gas Main Line.
