- SECTION 1. That Resolution 97-043 is hereby rescinded.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Borough Clerk is instructed to set for public hearing on July 15, 1997 a resolution of necessity for the establishment of the Robinson Loop Utility Special Assessment District for Construction of a Natural Gas Main Line.
