**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 97-083**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE'S COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM IN COOPERATION WITH THE
MOOSE PASS SPORTSMEN'S CLUB**

WHEREAS, notice has been received from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs that grant funding is available for the 1997 federal fiscal year through the Community Development Block Grant Program ("CDBG"); and

WHEREAS, eligible applicants include any municipal government entity defined by Title 29, except the Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, an eligible applicant may submit a CDBG application in cooperation with a non-municipal entity such as a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20, which is in good standing with the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Moose Pass Sportsmen's Club is a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20, in good standing with the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Moose Pass Sportsmen's Club has requested the Borough to submit an application in cooperation with them for a grant in an amount up to \$200,000 from the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs under the CDBG program for the renovation of the Moose Pass community complex; and


WHEREAS, a project involving the renovation of a community center meets the preliminary eligibility criteria as an activity with area-wide benefit under the CDBG program's community development category;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate, execute, and submit to the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs any and all documents required for a cooperative application on behalf of the Moose Pass Sportsmen's Club for a grant up to \$200,000 under the CDBG program for renovation of the community center.


SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
