- WHEREAS, an eligible applicant may submit a CDBG application in cooperation with a nonmunicipal entity such as a non-profit corporation organized under AS 10.20, which is in good standing with the State of Alaska; and

- WHEREAS, a project involving the renovation of a community center meets the preliminary eligibility criteria as an activity with area-wide benefit under the CDBG program's community development category;
