**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 1998 LEGISLATIVE
PRIORITY LIST TO INCLUDE THE KACHEMAK BAY
MULTI-PURPOSE OCEAN DOCK**

WHEREAS, on February 3, 1998, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly adopted Resolution 98-010, approving the 1998 Legislative Priority List; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly finds it is in the best interest of the Borough to amend this list to include the Kachemak Bay Multi-Purpose Ocean Dock among the STIP Projects of borough-wide significance;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough's 1998 Legislative Priority List is hereby amended to include the Kachemak Bay Multi-Purpose Ocean Dock Project as a STIP project of borough-wide significance, and the summary sheet attached and incorporated herein by reference is hereby added to the 1998 Legislative Priority Packet.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution and accompanying project summary sheet shall be provided to the Governor and all legislators representing the Kenai Peninsula Borough.


SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
